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# HOW TO USE THIS BOOK

Start on Monday and practice all week. There are two pages of activity for each day. First, write the **date** and your **starting** time. When you are finished, look at the time and write your **ending time**.

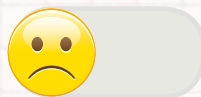
